GLOVES

Reusable:

Work or Garden Gloves

BUCKETS

YOUR TRUSTY CLEANUP CONTAINER

Re-Purpose:

- Ask local restaurants, delis, etc. for used, empty buckets. Commonly used for pickles, mayonnaise, and other bulk food items
- Reuse kitty litter containers, gallon water jugs, etc.
- Search social media marketplaces for used offers nearby
- Dumpster dive!



BAGS

GIVE THEM A SECOND CHANCE

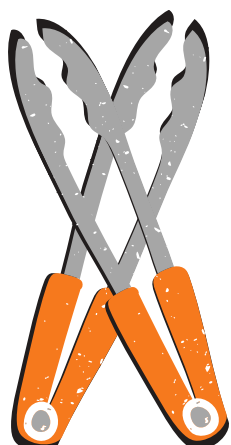
Re-Purpose:

- Canvas/reusable bags (wash after use)
- Grocery, produce, and takeout bags (paper and plastic - likely stored under your sink)
- Bread or chip bags
- Shipping bags/envelopes

SMALL CONTAINERS

FOCUS ON THE LITTLE THINGS

If you don't have a lot of bulky litter in your neighborhood, take the time to search out the little pieces! Microplastics - itty bitty pieces of broken down plastic - are just as important as bigger litter. Try to fill an empty, re-purposed jar, takeout container, coffee cup, etc. with those tiny bits!
